

Tour to GOF Itinerary

Thursday 6th – Friday 7th September 2018



The MGF,Z and Modern Register presents, on behalf of the MG Car Club, a 2 day Tour to the 2018 Gathering of the Faithful event in Wagga Wagga, NSW.

Gathering of the Faithful has been running for 23 years, and is a 2 day gathering for MG enthusiasts from all over Australia consisting of Social events, a Show and Shine and a Fun Run on Saturday, a Dinner on Saturday night and a BBQ breakfast and presentations on Sunday.

The Tour is over two days, Thursday 6th September and Friday 7th September 2018, and will start from the Clubrooms at 9.30 on Thursday, with the first day's run going via Yarra Glen, Yea, Mansfield, then up through the King Valley, through Milawa and on to a night stop at Beechworth, where we will have luxury accommodation at the George Kerferd Hotel and a dinner that night. The next morning (Friday), after the obligatory visit to the Beechworth Bakery for breakfast, the route goes through Yackandanda, along the Kiewa Valley Hwy, following the back end of Lake Hume, through the Historic High Country of NSW....Koetong, Cudgewa and on to Tumbarumba for lunch. Then on to Tumut and finally across the Hume to Wagga Wagga, where our accommodation is at the Mecure hotel, which just happens to be the central point for the Natter and Noggin and also the venue for the Saturday night dinner.
